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Prelude

In order to improve the quality of education at the tertiary level, the government of Bangladesh has taken several steps. The Higher Education Quality Enhancement Project (HEQEP) is one of such initiative. The University Grants Commission of Bangladesh (UGC) is the implementing agency of the project. The project is jointly financed by the World Bank and Government of Bangladesh, contributing 88 percent and 12 percent of the total cost respectively. Under HEQEP, a Quality Assurance Unit (QAU) was established at UGC in order to expedite the process of establishing quality culture at the universities. Towards targeting the establishment of quality culture at the universities, the Institutional Quality Assurance Cells (IQACs) have been established in all public and private universities. The QAU provides guidance to the concerned IQACs, and oversee the activities including Self-Assessment (SA) of degree programs during the project period.

Under the activities of IQAC, DIU following steps were followed:

- 1. Self-Assessment Process
- 2. External Peer Review Process
- 3. Post Self-Assessment Improvement Plan
- 4. Implementation Phase

1.0 Formation of IQAC at DIU

Institutional Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), DIU has started its journey during 14 June, 2015 through signing the performance contract with University Grants Commission of Bangladesh (UGC).

1.1 General Objectives of the IQAC, DIU

- To ensure quality culture as the prime concern for DIU through institutionalizing and internalizing all the initiatives taken with internal and external support.
- To develop a sustainable quality assurance mechanism for providing quality education of international standards;
- To produce skilled graduates for the competitive jobs in the national and international job markets; and
- To make effective contribution in creating a knowledge-based society through research and development (R&D) activities.

1.2 Specific Objectives of IQAC, DIU

- To review existing teaching-learning practices and other relevant aspects of higher education (contents, assessment procedures, course outcomes, use of technology, program orientation, academic performance, availability of resource materials, co-curricular activities etc.), existing policies, and procedures at the program offering entity level for further improvement through enhancing managerial efficiency;
- To identify the areas of improvement, such as, contents, instructional materials, delivery methods, capacity building, achievement of the course goals, and use of technology, support services, policy making etc. and plan relevant activities to ensure quality;
- To take initiatives and conduct appropriate activities through training, workshops, seminars, conferences, facilities development, orientations, awareness and capacity building etc. focusing on employers' needs and demands and respond to the global trends on quality education;
- To guide and assist the program offering entities (departments and faculties) to improve course objectives, student-centered teaching-learning methods, knowledge and skills of students and coordinate all quality assurance activities of the university with a view to produce skilled graduates for global markets;
- To provide support to the departments for conducting Self-Assessment (SA), External Peer Review and implement quality culture at the department; and
- To conduct research on quality education and prepare the university to meet the external quality assurance assessment and accreditation requirements.

"....Since 2000, there has been enormous progress in achieving the target of universal primary education. The total enrolment rate in developing regions reached 91 percent in 2015, and the worldwide number of children out of school has dropped by almost half. There has also been a


dramatic increase in literacy rates, and many more girls are in school than ever before. These are all remarkable successes. Progress has also been tough in some developing regions due to high levels of poverty, armed conflicts and other emergencies. In Western Asia and North Africa, ongoing armed conflict has seen an increase in the number of children out of school. This is a worrying trend. While Sub-Saharan Africa made the greatest progress in primary school enrolment among all developing regions – from 52 percent in 1990, up to 78 percent in 2012 – large disparities still remain. Children from the poorest households are up to four times more likely to be out of school than those of the richest households. Disparities between rural and urban areas also remain high. Achieving inclusive and quality education for all reaffirms the belief that education is one of the most powerful and proven vehicles for sustainable development. This goal ensures that all girls and boys complete free primary and secondary schooling by 2030. It also aims to provide equal access to affordable vocational training, to eliminate gender and wealth disparities, and achieve universal access to a quality higher education.

7.1 Outcome based Education (OBE)

Trainers Training on Quality Education, Research and Globalization

The workshop facilitator, Professor Dr. Mazumder holds various key positions like Program Evaluator, Accreditation Board of Engineering and Technology, USA, Director, American Society of Engineering Education, USA, Advisory Board Member, Center of Teaching and learning, University of Michigan-Flint.

In the workshop, Heads of the departments, Conveners and Members of Self-Assessment Committee of each SA Departments, Additional Director, IQAC, DIU, Dr. Md. Jashim Uddin, Director (Operations), admission.ac, Mr Ariful Alam and IQAC team members were present.

Director, IQAC, DIU, Professor Dr, A.K.M. Fazlul Haque, welcomed the participants and handed over the crest to the invited Key Facilitator, Professor Dr. Quamrul H. Mazumder, P.E. After the welcome session, Professor Dr. Mazumder started his key presentation. In his presentation, he has talked on several issues and global practices on quality in higher education and teaching learning practices.
